HILL HAPPENINGS: MEET SOME OF THE NEWSPAPER

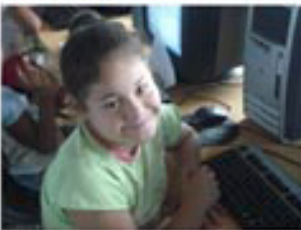
NAJAH SCOTT
